

Dear North Point Parents,

To align with the new provincial health measures, North Point is strengthening masking requirements.

Effective Monday, September 13th, a non-medical face mask will now be required while inside both of our campuses:

Masks for students and staff can be removed indoors while:

- Engaging in instruction and learning in a classroom
- Consuming food or drink
- Participating in physical exercise or options programming

This applies to the following:

- All students (Kindergarten - Grade 12)
- All staff members
- All visitors/volunteers

Masks will not be required outdoors and we will continue to support individuals who choose to wear a mask while in the classroom or outside.

As per the provincial requirements, masks continue to be required for all individuals (students, drivers, volunteers, and staff) on a school bus.

Please contact Mr. Devost or Mr. McClelland should a mask exemption be required for medical reasons.

We will continue to monitor the evolving situation and the new masking measures will be reviewed when there are changes in the provincial directions related to masking.

We recognize that there will be a variety of opinions on these new measures. North Point continues to focus on a balanced and thoughtful approach as we support the social, emotional, physical, and learning needs of our students while addressing provincial efforts to protect our healthcare system and reduce transmission of COVID-19.
